
SKYE STUART: "FEMALE FELONS"

Sherry Skye Stuart has lived in the Rocky Mountains for over fifty years. Forty of those years were spent in Fremont County Colorado raising her nine children and being active in the community. Sherry is an author, writer, artist, and yoga teacher. She has authored four books on Penrose and Fremont County History and edited one other Penrose history book:





SKYE STUART: "FEMALE FELONS" - CONTINUED
